A written confirmation of receipt of the report will be sent.**

Tournament fees must be paid in cash immediately upon arrival at the registration desk or credited to the RBC account by the Thursday before the tournament.

Otherwise, participation is not possible!

Helper horses are free if they are made available to other riders and are not registered as show horses.

A practice pen will only be offered if there are at least 5 registrations.

The classes RBC Open, RBC Non-Pro, RBC 75,000, RBC Amateur 25,000, RBC Amateur 4,000 and RBC Herd Work are recognized by RBC e. V.

In the RBC Open class, each rider is entitled to enter as many horses as they wish. In the RBC Non-Pro class, a rider is entitled to enter two horses. In all other RBC classes, except RBC Herd Work, each rider is entitled to enter one horse. A horse may enter multiple classes if the rider is eligible to do so.

Two horses are allowed in the NCHA USA Open class.

The first round, on Saturday, counts towards the NCHA of USA Weekend Show standings.

The second round, on Sunday, counts towards the NCHA of USA Challenger Show standings..

An entry for the Challenger Show on Sunday requires an entry in the Weekend Show on Saturday, in the same horse/rider/class combination.

The RBC Cutting competition is held in two rounds. The results of the first round (Saturday) and the second round (Sunday) are added together for the weekend ranking.

For the starting of horses in the RBC Non-Pro and RBC Amateur 25,000, the first degree of kinship counts.

In the RBC Amateur 75,000 class, riders are eligible to compete if their NCHA USA earnings have not exceeded \$75,000 as of January 1st of the show year. Both riders and horse owners must be active RBC members.

In the RBC Amateur 25,000 class, riders are eligible to compete if their NCHA USA earnings have not exceeded \$25,000 as of January 1st of the show year. Both riders and horse owners must be active RBC members.

In the RBC Amateur 4,000 class, riders are eligible to compete if their NCHA USA earnings have not exceeded \$4,000 as of January 1st of the show year. Both riders and horse owners must be active RBC members. There is no longer a two-year limit.

The RBC Amateur 4,000 class is eligible to compete if its rider has not exceeded \$4,000 as of January 1st of the show year. Both riders and horse owners must be active RBC members. In the RBC Amateur 4000 (NCHA 4000 Limit Rider) and the RBC Ranch Cutting and Herd Work, the horse does not need to be owned by the rider. However, both rider and horse owner must be active RBC members.

A youth rider is defined as someone who is still 18 years old on January 1, 2026. Please show your ID at the registration desk.

NCHA of Germany:

In the NCHA of Germany classes (NCHAoG ranking), there is no limit to the number of horses that can be entered. Riders and horse owners must hold a valid NCHAoG membership. For the Buckle Class, horse owners do not need to be NCHAoG members. All information about the Buckle Class can be found at www.ncha.de. The Open, Non Pro, \$25K Amateur, \$4K Limit Rider/AH, and Youth classes count towards the Highpoint ranking. To participate in the NCHAoG Highpoint ranking, riders and horse owners must hold a valid NCHAoG membership.

!!! Important Information !!!

Entry fees must be paid on-site before the show begins, as per the registration confirmation.

Entry is not permitted if entry fees from past NCHA USA, NCHAoG, or RBC shows have not been paid in full by the rider or owner.

!!! NCHA USA Standing Rule 4 !!!

Entries received after the closing date can only be accepted subject to the availability of stalls and cattle. These participants will be placed at the end of a go-in. Late entry fee: EUR 30.00 per horse-rider combination.

Entries without paid memberships or valid NCHA status will not be accepted.

Free cancellation is only possible until the entry deadline, even in case of illness of the horse or rider!

All horses brought to the tournament must present an equine passport with current vaccinations according to FN guidelines. For foreign participants, we recommend an official veterinary health certificate that is no more than 10 days old.

By signing this form, the participant confirms that the named horse is free of contagious diseases on the day of the competition, that they will bear the costs of any veterinary examinations should the horse show signs of illness, and that the horse is covered by liability insurance. The participant acknowledges the terms of the competition announcement, the NCHA-USA rulebook, and the NCHA-USA competition rules. The image, sound, and video rights for all material created by the organizer/tournament director or their authorized representatives remain with the aforementioned individuals. I consent to the storage and use of this data for competition purposes. The organizer reserves the right to change the competition announcement, reschedule the show, or cancel it with a refund of entries if special circumstances necessitate it. No contractual relationship exists between the organizer on the one hand and the visitors, horse owners, proprietors, and competition participants on the other. Therefore, all liability for theft and injury to people and animals is excluded. In particular, participants are not considered agents within the meaning of Sections 278f and 831 of the German Civil Code (BGB). Riders and owners are liable for damages caused by their horse to third parties or to the facilities of the organizer or the riding facility owner.
